



<i>Title:</i> Bicycle Locker Policy and Procedures	<i>Resolution:</i> 08-23
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PURPOSE:

It is the intent of this policy to provide bicycle lockers at strategic locations throughout the Jefferson Transit service area for the sole purpose of assisting daily transit riders who use a bicycle as part of their transportation plan.

SCOPE:

This policy applies to any approved applicant (hereby after referred to as “tenant”) for an indefinite period of time provided there have been no violations of a signed user agreement with Jefferson Transit and the procedures listed below are met.

PROCEDURES:

The tenant will complete a Jefferson Transit Bike Locker Application and Bike Locker Agreement form, consenting to the following:

- Bike Lockers are available on a first come, first served basis.
- Tenants must be over the age of 18; who regularly and consistently (three or more days in aggregate per week) commute part way by bicycle.
- A deposit of \$45.00 will be required for bicycle locker use.
- The locker will be used for the storage of a bicycle and bicycle accessories only.
- The tenant will retain use of the bicycle locker for an indefinite period of time provided there have been no violations of the signed user agreement; and a semi-annual renewal is complete, providing current tenant information.
- Bicycles with any combustion type engine or motor are excluded.

- Storage of any unrelated items or objects, including any combustible materials will result in immediate forfeiture of the locker and deposit.
- The locker shall not be used in, or in any connection with any activity prohibited by law.
- The tenant agrees to allow a Jefferson Transit representative to open and inspect the locker and its contents thereof at any time, without prior notice.
- Jefferson Transit assumes no liability and is not responsible for fire, theft, loss or damage to the contents of the bicycle locker.
- The tenant indemnifies and holds Jefferson Transit harmless from any and all liability of any nature arising from the use of the bicycle locker.
- The tenant is responsible to maintain the key issued to him or her or pay for a replacement key.
